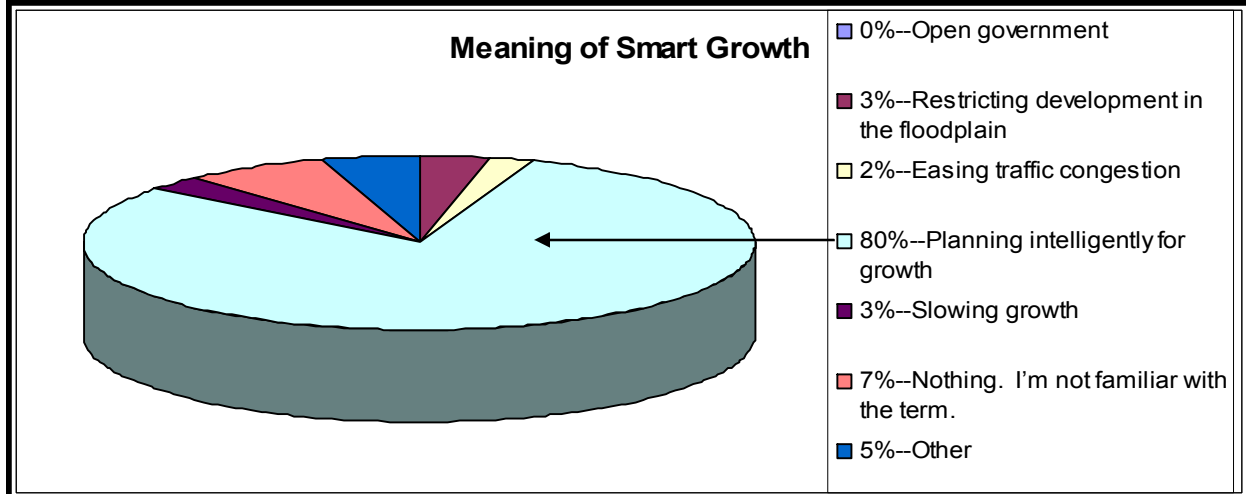


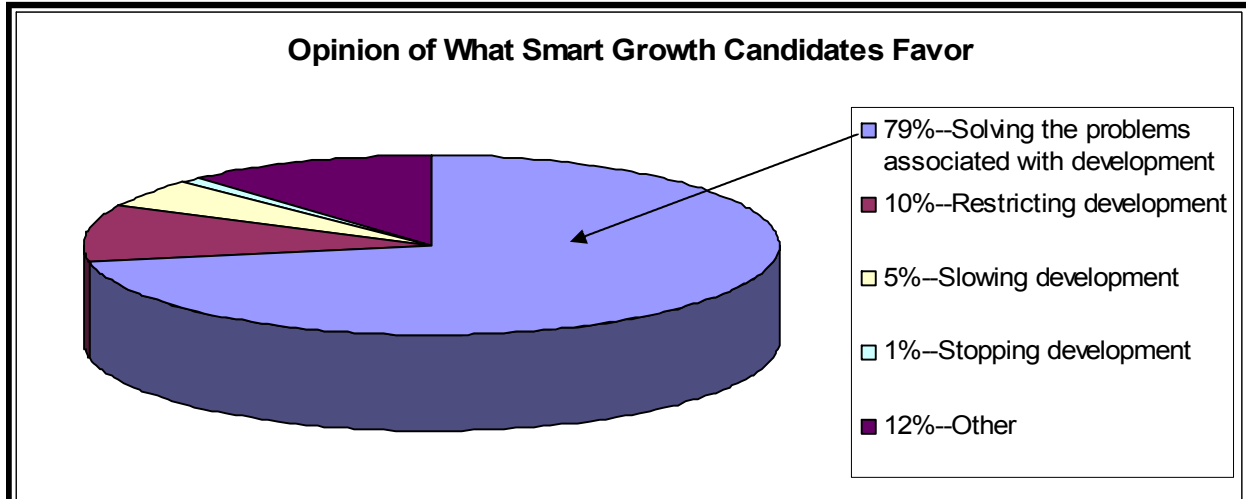


## Survey Results: Smart Growth

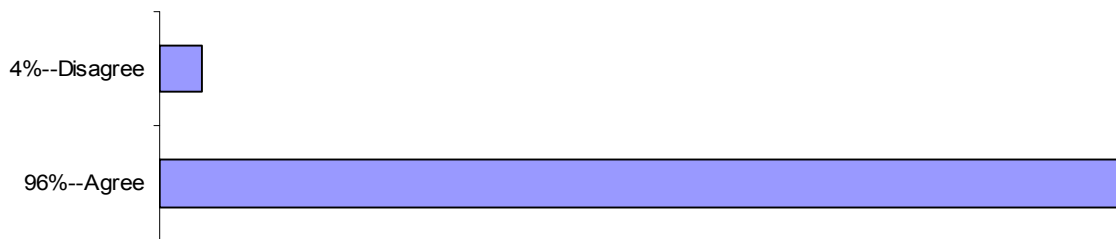
Question: When you hear the term "Smart Growth" which of the following comes to mind?



Question: When a political candidate is described as a "Smart Growth Candidate" you immediately think that the candidate favors:



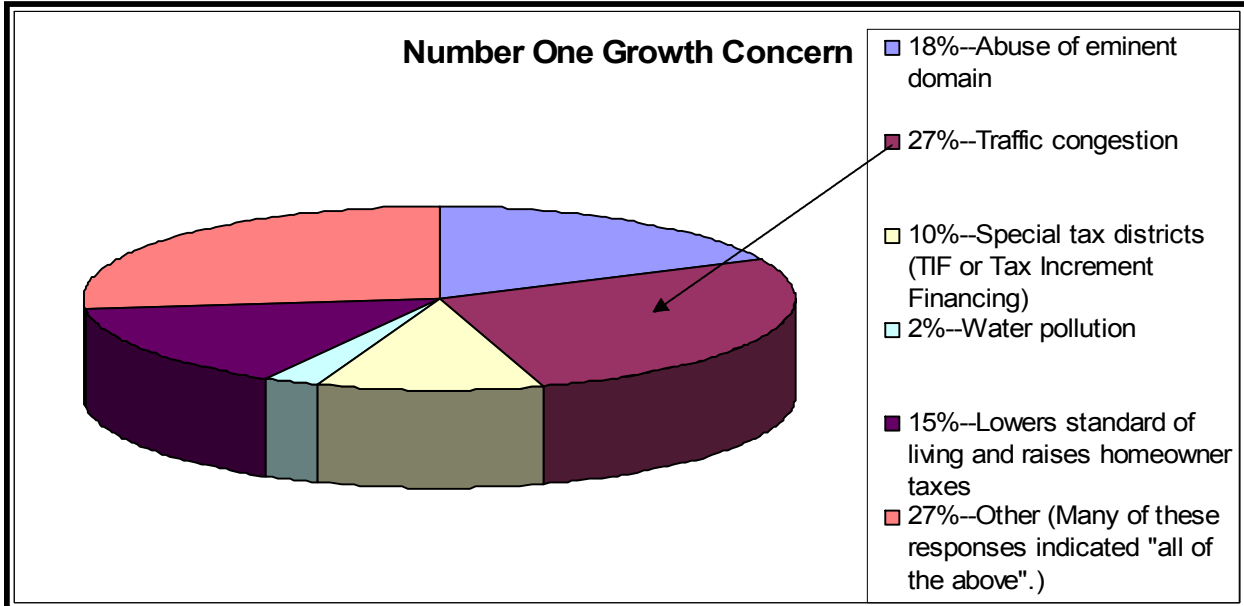
Question: Agree or Disagree? I'd like to know which candidates are primarily financed by developers or other pro-growth special interests.

| New taxes and fees being levied on property owners without voter consent              | 65%         | 25%             | 6%      | 2%          | 2%                      |
| Roads sewers and other infrastructure components that have not kept pace with growth  | 63%         | 31%             | 4%      | 0%          | 0%                      |
| Water and air pollution   | 53%         | 30%             | 11%     | 3%          | 0%                      |
